

HOW TO PLAY WITH YOUR POKEMON TAGS????

One Tag Match

1. First, insert 1 Pokémon tag into the Pokémon tag holder and place it faced down.
2. Next, flip the Pokémon tag up and the Pokémon strength will be revealed. Higher number wins in this case.
3. If Pokémon strengths are the same for both players, remove the Pokémon tag from the Pokémon tag holder and a bonus Pokémon strength number will be revealed.
4. Add both the numbers from the Pokémon tag and Pokémon tag holder up and the greater number wins.

Five Tags Match

1. First, insert 1 Pokémon tag into each Pokémon tag holder.
2. Each player will then select five Pokémon tag holders from their deck, shuffle them and place them faced down on the table.
3. At any one time, both players are to flip up one Pokémon tag holder simultaneously.
4. Add the Pokémon strength on the Pokémon tag and the bonus Pokémon strength number on the Pokémon tag holder together and the player with a higher combined Pokémon strength will win.
5. Repeat Step 3 till all the Pokémon tag holders have been flipped up and the player with the most number of wins is the champion. In the event of a tie, players can enter the “tie breaker match” to decide the overall winner.

Tie Breaker Match

1. In the event of a tie, both players will take back their 5 Pokémon tag holders, reshuffle them and place them faced down on the table.
2. Game play steps will not change but this time round, players get to pick from their opponent’s set of Pokémon tag holders to battle instead.
3. Only 1 Pokémon tag holder will be selected and after adding the Pokémon strength on the Pokémon tag and the bonus Pokémon strength number shown on the Pokémon tag holder together, the player with the higher combined Pokémon strength will win and be declared the champion of the match.
4. If it is still a tie, a second Pokémon tag holder will be selected and Step 3 will be repeated until there is a clear winner.
